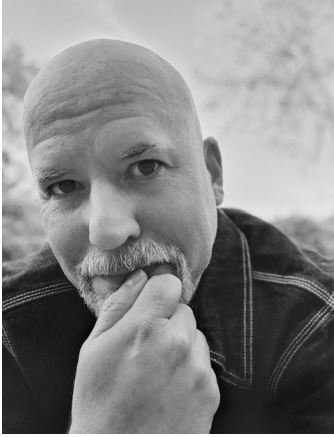


Jordan Scott Gaunce



Jordan Scott Gaunce combines painting and drawing to repeat geometric forms revealing the complexity of seemingly simple materials. Inspired by South Western culture and landscape, Gaunce's sleek graphic forms draw attention to details like the vibration between two colors, the reflection of light on acrylic, or the grain of his wooden base.

"My work bridges art and science, drawing inspiration from the natural world, my New Mexican roots, and the exploration of consciousness. I investigate the patterns shaping existence, from the cellular structures of life—spanning single-celled organisms to the most complex mammals—to subatomic particles such as light. The vibrant landscapes of the Southwest, rich in cultural and spiritual significance, ground my exploration of universal systems.

Through abstract paintings, I use color theory to create gradients, combined with simple geometries—lines, circles, and forms. Portals in my work symbolize voids that span scales from planets to atoms, serving as spaces for contemplation and meditation. These elements reflect my fascination with the networks connecting life, awareness, and the cosmos. At its core, my work asks the question: What does it mean to be human in an interconnected universe?" -Artist Statement
