Alessandero Gallo's sculptures blend together human and faunal anatomy to portray current events, ranging from political headlines to linguistic tics. Each animal is selected for its social connotations or idiomatic expressions, projecting a stereotype on its human counterpart and the implications and values projected onto social subcultures.

The artist's distinguished career has included residencies at the Archie Bray Foundation and the Northern Clay Center, the Virginia A Groot Foundation Grant Prize, and presentation as Demonstrating Artist at the NCECA Conference.
